Elly gives credit to her family and friends for supporting her journey with pickleball and helping to reset her mind when feeling discouraged, "having people pour into me and remind me what I am capable of even when I don't see that in myself is really important."

Her advice to players her own age looking to imitate the growth she has experienced is, "Ask the questions, make yourself uncomfortable in order to grow yourself."
